Most of you reading this will know that Cleveleys Christian Centre & New Waters Christian Fellowship have joined together to become, as the logo tell us, New Waters Christian Centre. There was some debate about the name, several suggestions put forward, both Churches agreed on the 'best fit' solution, and the new Church was birthed. Both Pastors, Paul Croft & Alan Drake, hold full ministerial credentials, Paul with Assemblies of God and Alan with Elim Church Incorporated. The two movements have historically shared the same platform on many occasions and their constitutional differences are minor. Paul and Alan see the new partnership as a great step forward, both congregations spent time in prayer before they entered into any definite discussions. They share the vision of impacting the Cleveleys area with a fresh approach to Church and place great emphasis on the move of the Spirit of God combined with sound Biblical teaching. While their styles of ministry are different, the complimentary nature provides a natural balance and in many ways forms a strengthened Pastoral approach.

The 'New Waters' meetings are diverse in so much as they are given over to the Lord God. Paul & Alan are open to what He has for the people, if that is quiet prayerful worship or lively flag waving joyful praise, as long as it gives honour and glory to Father in Heaven then it is a case of 'as the Lord leads'.

The services have seen a change too! As well as regular communion on a Sunday morning at 10.30am, Spring Waters for the children and youth led by Lynne & Nick, also the first Sunday of the month will see evening meetings at 6.30pm, weekly prayer nights are currently Thursdays at 7.30pm.

On Sunday 1st June, we have a guest speaker for both morning and evening meetings; Chanti Raju from India who is currently touring the UK. Pastor Chanti Raju lives and ministers in Vijayawada, in the Andhra Pradesh area of Southern India. He is a Lawyer and also the director of Good News Ministry, which was established in 1988 to bring the Good News of the gospel to the people of Southern India, and establish places of fellowship and care based upon the New Testament model. GNM have about 50 churches and 40 pastors, a children's home (Christ Children's Home), widow's home (Nightingale Home) and a Free Legal Aid Centre to assist the poor. The ministry is evangelistically based; bringing the gospel to the people of the towns and villages. It also has a strong social base because of the poverty of the people in village life. They open bore wells in the villages whenever financially possible, and this also grants opportunity to share the gospel in the mainly Hindu communities.
